
Literature Review – Knowledge base

- Knowledge base:
 - What is the knowledge base?
 - → collection of evaluation reports, papers, meta-studies, guidelines on evaluation issues, not representative, not exhaustive, could be a living document
 - What is the objective ?
 - → make knowledge/experiences available to stakeholders
 - How to get access to these information?
 - → this is the topic we like to discuss now!



Knowledge base – put into the EPATEE framework


The knowledge base is just one knowlege element of EPATEE, which will feedin information in an online tool box (as one outcome of the EPATEE project)





Knowledge base – (2) questions

- 1. How would you like to search in this knowledge base
 - selection criteria with dropdown menu
 - simple search: a selected set of criteria/variables
 - advanced search: based on all variables available in the knowledge base
- 2. What information you like to get?
 - all or
 - selection?
- → see suggestions





Knowledge base - (3) suggestions

our suggestion of selection criteria:

for simple search:

- type of study
- instrument
 - legislative/normative
 - legislative/informative
 - financial
 -
- sector
 - buildings
 - households
 - industry
 - ...
- geographical scope

for advanced search:

all criteria

all available information:


- title
- link (www or pdf)
- author/organisation
- date of publication
- language
- geographical scope
- type of study
- objective of evaluation
- instrument
- sector
- data collection
- calculation method
- baseline
- results on energy savings net/gross
- other impacts
- adjustments
- normalisation
- cost data
- uncertainty




Some numbers on evaluation studies

- number of evaluations by regions or countries


