


Involved stakeholders came from EU and abroad

EPATEE's coverage





**Stakeholders' engagement has been one of the main EPATEE's activities.**

Respondents to the 1st survey




## Main outcomes from interviews and surveys



Among the barriers the main ones are:  

- insufficient financial resources,
- lack of interest from policy makers and public managers,
- lack of reliable data to evaluate non energy effects



Some quotes from the interviews and surveys:

*The necessity [of evaluation] is out of question. It is imperative to know if a measure worked in order to continue using it.*

*Evaluation is equally important for creating new policies and adapting existing ones.*

*Politicians are mainly interested in new policies, not in evaluation of existing ones.*

*We recurrently hear in our meetings with ministries the argument our-country-is-already-doing-well-and-we-do-not-need-to-do-more.*

*One main barrier is not the conduct of the actual evaluation in itself, but its dissemination and use.*


*Many policy initiatives include soft measures (e.g. information and campaigns) which are challenging to evaluate in terms of impacts (on GHG emissions, energy consumption).*
