

ABOUT THE PROJECT

EPATEE (Evaluation Into Practice to Achieve Targets for Energy Efficiency) is an EU funded project which aims at providing EU Member States with knowledge and tools allowing a better evaluation of their energy efficiency policies. This 30-month project (May 2017 to October 2019) is led by a consortium of 10 partners from 8 European countries.

❖ Why evaluation shall be looked at?

The EU Directives on energy efficiency such as the Energy Efficiency Directive (EED) or the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD) are triggering the establishment of a great variety of policies in EU Member States. But how effective are these policies in achieving energy savings targets? Several barriers limit policy evaluation and thus hinder target-based adaptations of energy efficiency policies.

❖ What the project will do?

TOOLS BUILDING

To assist policymakers and implementers in the evaluation of their energy efficiency policies, the EPATEE project develops various tools based on the analysis of existing evaluation experiences such as energy efficiency obligation schemes, regulations, financial incentives and voluntary agreements. Lessons learnt from these examples will provide the basis for the development of guidelines and a smart online toolbox for good evaluation practices.

EXPERIENCE SHARING AND CAPACITY BUILDING

Peer learning workshops and webinars are organized for national authorities and energy efficiency policy stakeholders. Those experience sharing and direct support events offer the opportunity to discuss the main issues related to policy evaluation practices and to feed into the tools building phase.
